Your ADHD Program

Preparing for Your Appointment



Treatment for ADHD can help in many ways, but it must be managed on a continual basis. It will help a child have better relationships with parents, teachers, and peers, improve school performance and decrease problems with behavior. It is important to get a proper diagnosis and help early in life.

If your child has NOT YET been diagnosed with ADHD,

but is inattentive or hyperactive, and needs an evaluation, please follow the steps below prior to scheduling an ADHD appointment.

Click on 'ADHD' icon to the left of our website homepage. Read the parent letter on our website before your visit.

Complete the initial Parent Vanderbilt Assessment forms prior to your visit. You can print these forms from our website.

Have two teachers complete the initial Teacher Vanderbilt Assessment prior to your visit.

It is recommended that your child have a psycho-educational evaluation with a psychologist prior to your visit. This evaluation can be done through your child's school (free) or privately. Please check with your insurance to see who is covered privately, and check our website for a list of recommended psychologists.

If your child HAS ALREADY been diagnosed with ADHD,

we recommend comprehensive ADHD evaluations at a minimum every six months in addition to yearly check-ups. This includes the following:

- Reassessment of Vanderbilt Scores by parents
- Medication updates or changes if necessary
- Screening for medication side-effects
- Evaluation for disorders which sometimes occur in children with ADHD – depression, anxiety, oppositional behaviors, obsessive or compulsive behaviors
